

Rules and Regulations

By registering for the Davos X-Trails you automatically agree to the competition rules and regulations.

1 The organization

The Davos X-Trails are organized by the Davos X-Trails Association. The purpose of the association is to plan, organize and carry out the running event «Davos X-Trails» in Davos.

2 General

These regulations are part of the contract between organzier and runner. Also in case of registration of other or additional persons (third parties) the regulations are valid. The organizer assumes that these third parties have authorized the registering person to register. In case of registration of underage runners by third parties, the organizer assumes that the legal representatives have given their agreement.

Companies that are responsible for the organization and execution of the running event, the processing of registrations (online, offline), the administration of the participants' data, the timing, results service, bib processes, participant advertising and information, process the data on our behalf.

3 Registration

The Registration takes place online via www.davos-xtrails.ch/en and is realised in cooperation with Datasport. The entry fee must be paid in accordance with the announcement. All those who register by Sunday 21.07.2024 will receive a personalised start number with their name. The online registration is open until Thursday midnight 25 July 2024. Late registrations and changes are possible on site at the race number distribution point.

4 Re-registration, Cancellation, Refund

A change of the competition is possible until the day of competition. Higher entry fees and options will be charged. A refund or credit of overpaid entry fees is excluded. In case of re-registration in another competition, the benefits of the corresponding competition are automatically valid. There is no right to a refund in case of a reduction in performance. In the case of a cancellation, the race number can be transferred to another person for a fee of CHF 10.00.

In the case of a start renunciation, any claim for refund of the entry fee or carry-over to the following year is cancelled. If the participant is unable to participate due to symptoms, illness or accident (with or without a doctor's certificate), there is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee.

When registering, there is the optional possibility of taking out a cancellation costs insurance. In case of illness, accident or other reasons according to the cancellation conditions, the paid entry fee will be refunded upon presentation of a medical certificate.

If the race cannot be held or can only be held partially due to force majeure, extraordinary risks or official orders, there is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee.

5 The competition

- · Fair sportsmanship is required.
- No license is required.
- The bib is personally and must be worn in front, clearly visible and unfolded. Modifications to the bib will cause disqualification.
- The time is measured with a disposable chip integrated in the bib.
- All participants, except in case of injury or exhaustion, must stop the competition only at control posts.
- Any costs for a search will be charged to the participant.



6 The distances

Diamond, 68 kilometres (67.6 km) from Davos to Davos, +/- 2606 m (can also be completed in teams of 3)

Gold, 43 kilometres (42.7 km) from Davos to Davos, +/- 1'424 m

Silver, 23 kilometres (23.6 km) from Klosters to Davos, +631 m / -279 m

Bronze, 10 kilometres (9.3 km) from Davos to Davos, +/- 163 m

- The four different runs with different distances must be completed within a fixed time limit.
- Shortcuts are not allowed.

6.1 Course marking

The course will be marked with flags, route tape, marking spray and information signs.

6.2 Cut off times

The broom bike marks the end of the regular race. Doctors on the course as well as the medical service are authorized to take participants out of the race for medical reasons. Participants who miss the control closing times will receive a note on their bib and will be disqualified from the race. Participants arriving after a control closing time will not be classified and will not be able to use X-Trails services (food, medical, course guards, timing, ranking, etc.).

7 Mandatory equipment

All runners of the **Diamond** and **Gold** run are obliged to take the following equipment with them during the entire race. There can be controls at the starting area.

- Drinking cup
- Rain jacket
- Emergency kit (warming blanket, self-adhesive bandage)
- Whistle
- Smartphone with stored emergency number 081 414 85 77
- 1liter water for Diamond, 0.5 liter water for Gold

All **Silver** and **Bronze** runners are strongly recommended to take a **drinking cup** with them.

Please note: Rapid weather changes and temperature fluctuations may occur on the alpine section of the course. Participants are responsible for good clothes.

8 Race Refreshments

On the separate refreshments plan you will find the details of exact locations and the different nutritional refreshments along the Davos X-Trails courses. Trash cans are placed at the refreshment's zones. Littering is prohibited throughout the course and will result in disqualification.

9 Self-responsibility

Participation is at your own risk and responsibility. Regular endurance training and good health are requirements for a start. It can be life-threatening to start with or directly after infectious diseases (e.g. flu).

10 Company and support

Personal assistance by coaches is only allowed in the area around the food/water zones within a radius of 50 meters. Any accompanying of the participants on the course (e.g. by mountain bike or by running with them) is prohibited. Pacemakers are not allowed.

During the KIDS-Run it is forbidden for parents to run along the course.

11 Safety and medical care

Davos X-Trails has a comprehensive medical and safety concept. In case of incidents, weaknesses of runners and accidents, please immediately go to the nearest course or medical post and ask for help.

12 Change of course and cancellation

Due to force majeure or extraordinary risks, the organizer can adapt, shorten or even cancel the whole race at any time and without notice. In the event of a change of the course, the timing will be continued as best as possible.



13 Results / Award ceremony

Participants will be categorized in age groups according to gender. At the award ceremony only the overall podium runners per race will be honored with special prizes. In the "Diamond TEAM", the total time of all three runners in the women's, men's and mixed categories is counted. Participants who do not take part in the award ceremony will automatically forfeit their prize.

14 Liability / Insurance

The organizer Davos X-Trails refuses any liability. This also applies to accidents, theft and liability towards third parties. Insurance is the responsibility of the participants. Each runner must have a personal accident insurance. This must include costs for rescue and recovery as well as healing. Claims for damages by the participants against the organizer, regardless of the legal basis, are excluded.

15 Data Privacy

The use of personal data is regulated in the applicable data privacy declaration. The runner undertakes to provide the organizer with the personal data of third parties only if they, or their legal representatives, are aware of the applicable data protection declaration and they are entitled to do so in accordance with applicable data protection law.

The photos and film recordings made in connection with our running event may be used on TV, the Internet, in our own advertising materials, magazines and books (print media) without any claims to reimbursement.

16 Complaint

Complaints must be submitted in writing to the race management in Davos, at the latest one hour after the athlete concerned has crossed the finish line.

The race management is entitled to pass judgment on all cases of doubt that have arisen during the competition. No recourse is possible against the decisions of the race management.

17 Jurisdiction

The place of jurisdiction is Davos.
